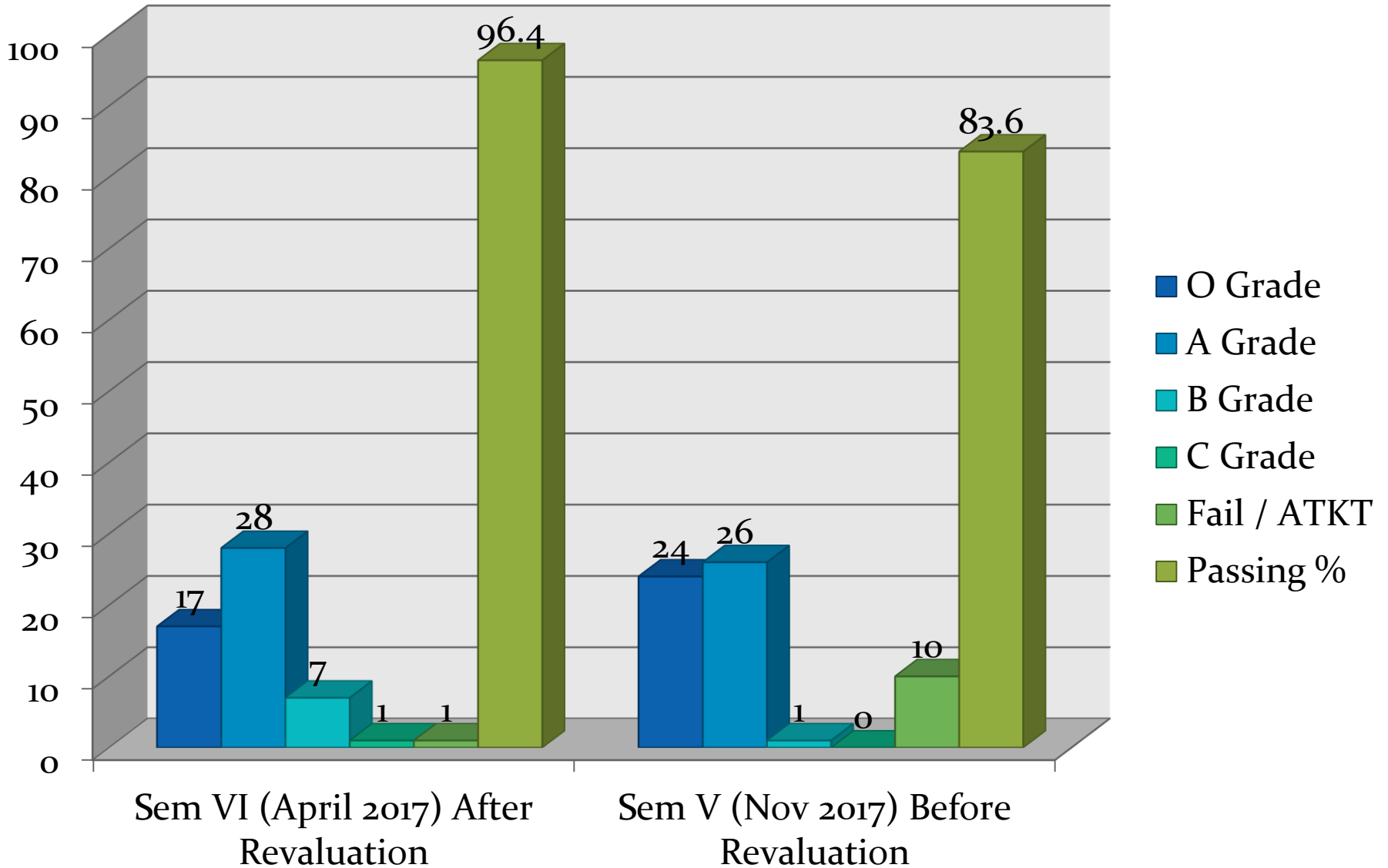

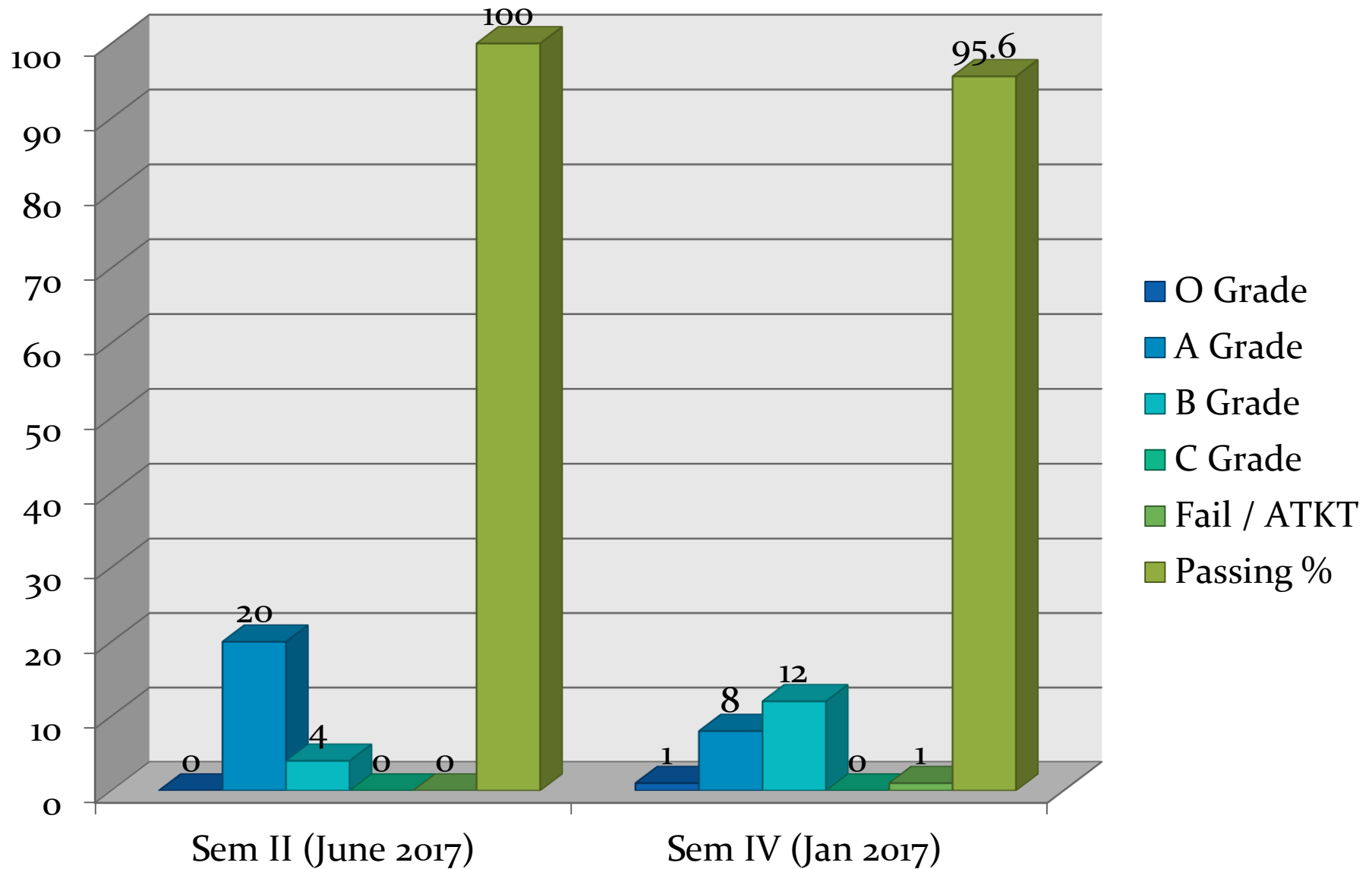

Efforts taken to improve Student Performance
