
#### **Academic Activities**

Under these two grants, a number of outstanding activities were conducted.



The passing percentage for the 12<sup>th</sup> Arts was an astounding 100%, for Science was 99.63%, and for commerce was 99.8%.

## Degree College-





- KC was also the **overall winner at Jai Hind College festival**, SHOUTT.


