
Academic Activities

The college has completed the tenure of the **UGC Paramarsh Scheme** in which 7 non- NAAC accredited colleges were mentored with an aim to becoming NAAC accredited. KC College is proud to announce the success of this programme since one of the mentee colleges, Sterling College, has prepared its NAAC SSR report and uploaded it on NAAC website. The other 6 colleges are in the process of making their SSR ready.

A number of new academic initiatives were taken in the past year :-

- 2021-22 was the second year of a programme in **BSc in Data Science** and **Business Analytics** under the new HSNC University.
- Introduction of the 3-years credit based **Honours programme** for Degree students- Honours programme in Health & Diagnostics was introduced for Science students. Another Honours programme in Law & Statistics was introduced for Commerce students.
- Introduction of the 3-year **B.Voc. Programme in Sports & Entertainment Management** in the Department of Mass Media. In the previous year, B.Voc. in Web Technology had already been introduced.




10th February 2022: The Department of Economics in association with SEBI & AMFI held a national level webinar on "Opportunities and Innovations in Indian Capital Markets".
