Subsequently, applicants must submit one original and 05 photocopies of the application form to the undersigned, along with 03 separate sets of mark sheets for all examinations, testimonials, No Objection Certificates from the present employer, caste certificates, validity certificates if any, experience certificates, appointment letters, list of publications, seminars/workshops attended, membership on various authorities/bodies of the KC College and University, to KC College with its soft copy sent to Email ID **office@kccollege.edu.in** with applicant's name, applied post, and category in the subject line.

The above post(s) are open to all however, candidates from any category can apply for the post. Reservations for women & disabled persons will be as per rules. Candidates having knowledge of Marathi will be preferred.

The required minimum qualifications for the post of Assistant Professor are as follows:

(i) A good academic record as defined by the concerned University with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade on a point scale wherever a grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in a relevant subject from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University.

(ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.

(iii) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clauses (i) and (ii) above, candidates who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Colleges/Institutions.

(iv) NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programs in disciplines for which NET/SELT/SET is not conducted.

A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the graduate and master's levels for the Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Differently-abled (Physically and visually differently-abled) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment to teaching positions. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade on a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% for the categories mentioned above are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures.

A relaxation of 5% may be provided, from 55% to 50% of the marks, to the Ph.D. Degree holders who obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19th September 1991.

Applicants who are already employed must send their application through proper channels. Applicants are required to account for any breaks, if any in their academic career. Details of the qualifications pay-scale allowance will be supplied on request from applicants.
