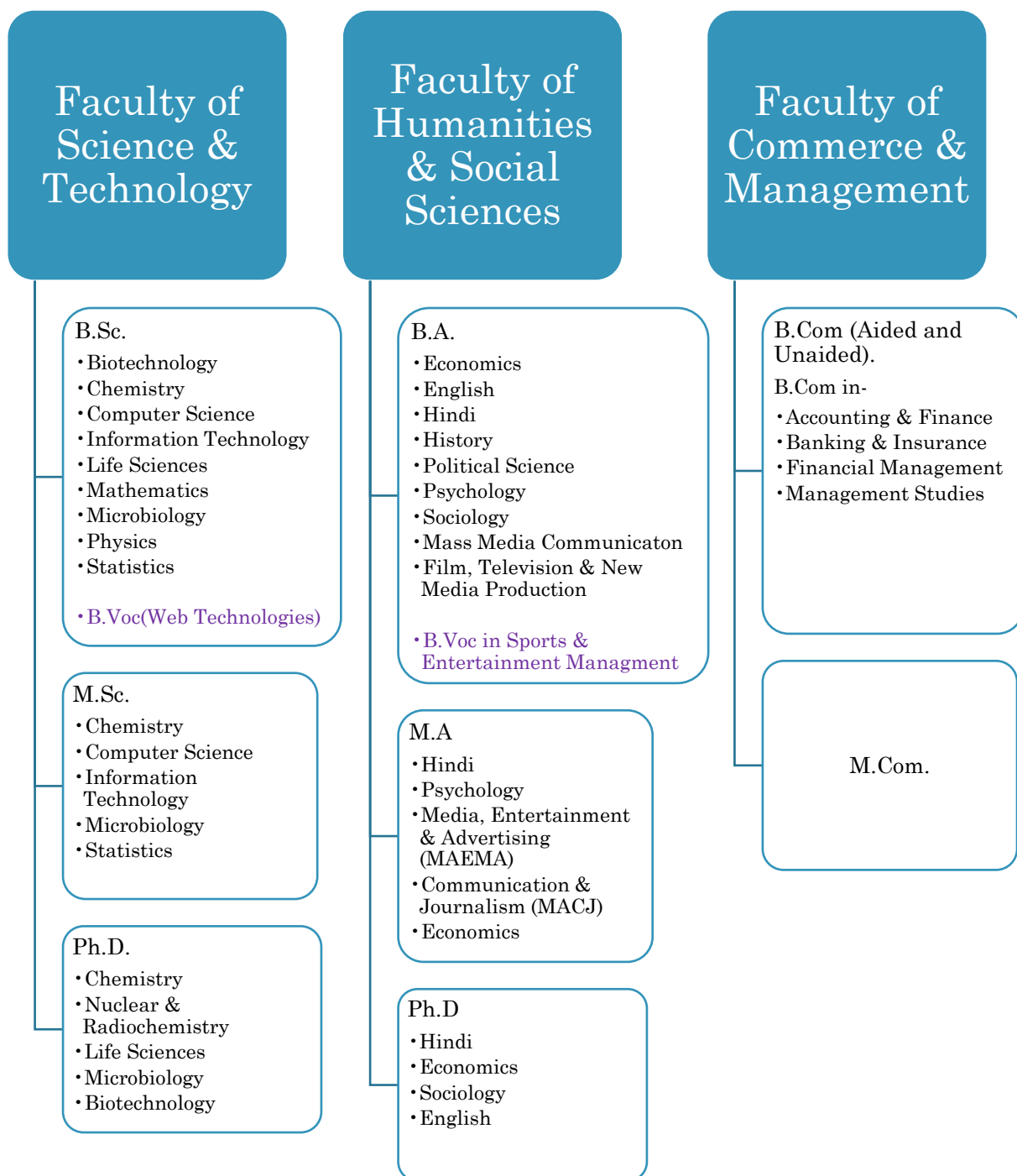



**About the Certificate Course**

An initiative of the Department of Sociology and Gender Issues Cell, Certificate Course in Gender Studies started in 2014 to help build a critical feminist perspective and to foster interdisciplinary linkages. Our resource persons are drawn from diverse fields of inquiry and include academics, filmmakers, feminist lawyers, activists and trans advocacy groups. Teaching methods include a combination of lectures, screenings, group work, case studies, presentations, and discussions with an emphasis on participatory approaches and experiential learning.

**Course Objectives**

- To promote a nuanced understanding of basic concepts in gender studies
- To use an intersectional lens to understand the multilayered nature of gender oppression
- To foster interdisciplinary linkages

**Course Outcomes**

### 4. CERTIFICATE COURSE of LAW, JUSTICE & RIGHTS

Certificate course in law, justice and rights is an initiative of the department of Sociology kc college. It started in 2022 in collaboration with TKNY Advocates and Legal Reservoir. This course is an attempt to understand everyday practices of legal system and its relationship with justice. Some of the modules included sessions on topics like -constitution and laws, criminal justice systems, family law, and laws and marginalized groups.

### 5. Jigyasa-Science Honors Programme (SHP)

Jigyasa- Science Honors Programme was initiated in the golden jubilee year of K.C. College, 2004. This programme aims to enhance the communication skills of students as well

as orient them towards research. In the past 19 years of the SHP programme, a number of research papers have been published in international and national peer reviewed journals. The one-year programme culminates in the Research Scholars Meet at which students present their research findings and are judged by external experts. Both SHP and CPCA together conduct summer and winter school modules like, research paper writing, life skills, word press and other computer skills.

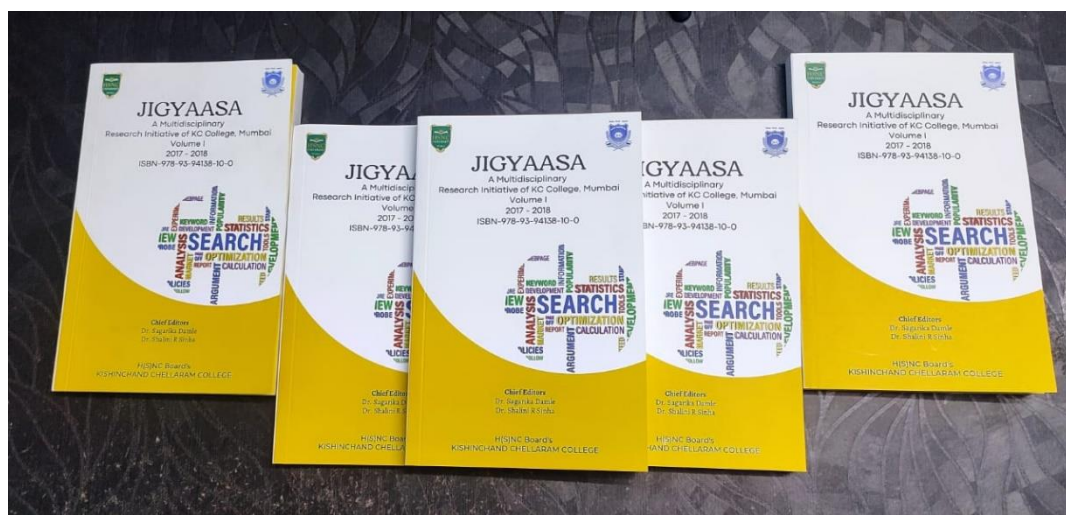

Mumbai: Mohammed Moiz Yusuf Chaudhary, 18, is a mini-celebrity in his middle-class Byculla neighbourhood. Reason: his silver winning feat in the National Swimming Championship held in New Delhi recently.

Manoj Palekar, his coach at the YMCA's swimming pool in Mumbai Central, told this correspondent, "The boy is very ziddi (obdurate). He was injured and many people advised him not to participate in the championship. However, he went ahead and won three golds. He is determined to win more medals. He is a hardworking boy." Moiz next target: to make it to Khelo India, a talent search and development programme aimed at producing sports champions.

What makes the boy's success significant is his background — he does not come from a family with sporting genes. However, Moiz wants to buck the trend. "We encouraged him to swim as we did not want him to get influenced by boys who do drugs and kill their time in useless pursuits. We wanted him to be away from all the bad habits. Since he was doing well in swimming, we encouraged him to pursue it. He has not disappointed us," his proud father said.
